

Margaret Allan Legacy

The Community Council has been bequeathed the sum of £10,000 for the benefit of our Community thanks to the kindness and generosity of local benefactor Margaret Allan.

Margaret was the daughter of William and Elizabeth Allan, whose family farmed Mains of Loirston as a dairy farm for many years. Right up until early 2009 her brother Sandy's cattle grazed the fields where the new Charleston houses now stand. Sandy set up The Mains of Loirston Charitable Trust which offers educational grants for studying agriculture in schools, colleges and universities in Scotland. Older residents will remember that Mrs Allan kicked off the first ball at Allan Park during its opening in 1950, the family having given over that field to the community.
