



### **Dive into the Library with the Wild Dolphins**

This summer over 30 miniature dolphin sculptures will form an art trail across Aberdeen City Libraries as part of the Wild in Art Wild Dolphins project. The sculptures have been designed by school children from across the Aberdeen City and Shire region and will be on display in ten libraries in Aberdeen from Monday 23rd June until Friday 29th August.

A number of dolphin-themed activities for children will be held in participating libraries throughout the summer, in partnership with Whale and Dolphin Conservation. The dolphin sculptures will be displayed in Airyhall, Bridge of Don, Bucksburn, Central Children's, Dyce, Ferryhill, Kincorth, Mastrick, Tillydrone and Torry libraries.
