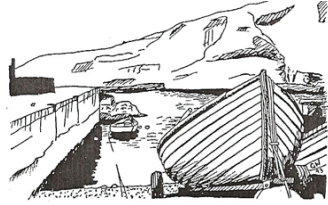


Chairman's Notes

Planning Matters

Leiths Quarry advise that their deliveries of rocks to the new Nigg Harbour development will be run down during July and will recommence probably in March 2018.

Unit 4, Loirston Avenue: Plans for a hot food takaway were passed by the Council with conditions regarding noise and odour.

Proposed 6MWp Solar PV development and associated Battery Storage at Mains of Charlestown Farm, Land to the South of the A90, Charlestown, Aberdeen.
Proposed erection of 1.5 storey front extension also formation of 3 rooflights at 1 Spark Terrace, Old Cove.

A Traffic order on Wellington Road, in place from 17th July to 21st August, is in the interests of public safety during sewer connection works for the new Craiginches development.
