



Cove Harbour Update

As you know, Pralhad Kolhe, the owner of Cove Harbour has demanded that the fishing boats and all associated equipment are removed from the harbour area. In addition he has stated that no vehicles should be parked at the harbour. This would make it impossible to continue the long established fishing heritage of Cove, should he succeed with these demands. Not only will this affect the fishermen but it will seriously impact on other harbour visitors such as divers, kayakers, rod fishers, disabled individuals who also rely on transport down to the harbour.

Cove Fishermen's Association is actively opposing this move and the next procedural hearing at the court will be on 20th July. This will decide how the case will be heard i.e. via debate or via proof by evidence, probably in late August or early September
