If they have been well coached like ours, they should know what to do on the field. If they make a mistake, chances are they will learn from it. Make positive comments from the sideline. Be encouraging. Young players do not need to be reminded constantly about their perceived errors or mistakes. Their coaches will instruct them, either during the game or at half time, and during practices. You can often see a young player make that extra effort when they hear encouraging words from the sideline.
