Between 15 and 17 October, several premises within the Altens Industrial Estate and the new housing development at Charleston in Cove Bay were the subject of several housebreakings. This caused significant concern due to the number of crimes within such a short period of time and the value of property stolen. Following a very focused and thorough enquiry between uniformed officers based at Nigg and the CID, the person responsible was arrested in Aberdeen and stolen property recovered. He was charged with 5 housebreakings and the theft of £5000 worth of property, resulting in a 6 month prison sentence.

Bonfire night came and went and despite some issues involving youths in other areas, it was not problematic for the emergency services in Nigg.

Acquisitive crime remains a concern throughout the city and there have been several housebreakings in the Kincorth area which we are dedicating our staff and specialist resources. High visibility and plain clothes patrols have been carried out with support from the Dog Section. Due to the joint operation between Nigg CPT and the CID, the person responsible for the housebreakings in Cove was caught on Wednesday. He appeared at Aberdeen Sheriff Court on Thursday where he pled guilty and was remanded in custody.

As the festive period approaches, it is important that houses, garages and cars are kept locked. Please check your doors and windows before

going to bed and remind your families to do likewise.

The Cove area is an extremely safe place to live, please help us keep it that way.
