Pharmacy Collections

Although we are not required to do so, as a benefit to our patients we take part in some pharmacy collections whereby we record in your records that your prescriptions are to be collected by a specified pharmacy. If you have chosen a pharmacy collection service, this will mean that ALL prescriptions that we process for you will automatically be forwarded on to the pharmacy.

This means that if you speak to one of our Duty Doctors and they issue you with a prescription this will automatically go to your chosen pharmacy unless you advise the Doctor otherwise.
