Cadets have been assisting the Countryside Ranger Service in several of their winter events throughout Aberdeen in local nature reserves and parks.

The main focus was the improvement of the environment for local flora and wildlife. This consisted of cleaning up a wetland area to aid aquatic wildlife, cutting down gorse and broom encroaching on heathland areas and finally clearing Spruce tree saplings where they were holding back the establishment of the Scots Pine whose seeds is the favourite food of Red squirrels.

All the cadets had great fun on these days working with other young people and members of the public. The gorse clearing events were especially popular as they looked forward to baked potatoes and roasting marshmallows on the bonfire at the end of the day.

The community activity days will count towards both the John Muir Trust and Saltire Awards which we are actively promoting for the cadets.
