East Tullis Incinerator Update

Timeline:

We must express our great disappointment that the Aberdeen Incinerator project, to be located in East Tullis, in Torry is to progress to the next stage. This involves working up technical details and costs of construction of both the incinerator and the associated district heating scheme. This is a lengthy process and it will be 2018/2019 before a SEPA permit will be applied for.

Planning Matters

P161759/S42: Leiths Quarries Managing Director came along to our last meeting. He talked us through their plans for increased productivity resulting in an extra hour to their working day and 24 hour movement of lorries, 2nd May to 18th July, 2017, (excluding Sunday) to fulfil their contract with the new Harbour at Nigg. The Community Council will be commenting on this proposal.
