

New mixed recycling bins coming to Cove

A new communal mixed recycling service is being rolled out city wide to provide flats, tenemental properties, multi-storeys and courtyards with a convenient recycling service.



This will help increase recycling rates across the city and meet targets set out in the Scottish Government Zero Waste Plan 2010 and the Aberdeen City Waste Strategy.

Along with the food recycling bins that have already been installed, the residents in Cove will be receiving a full recycling service commencing from 2016.

This new service will be easier and more convenient for residents to use.

The communal mixed recycling service will enable residents to recycle everything in one bin: paper and cardboard, plastic bottles and containers,

metal tins and cans, foil and trays, glass bottles and jars.

A similar service will be rolled out to individual households from 2017, where their kerbside box and bag scheme will be replaced with a mixed recycling 240l wheeled bin with a blue lid.



The first areas to receive the service will be Bridge of Don, Seaton, Hanover and Torry. We will continue the roll out of the service in the south part of the city and proceeding clockwise through to the North and finally in the inner city areas and Froghall and George Street areas.
