Cove Youth FC have been chosen to be used as a pilot for a brand new SFA programme. The McDonalds Community Club Project is a new initiative which will see a member of the SFA coaching staff work individually with the club coaches for approximately six months. The project is in association with McDonalds, who part fund the programme. The North region were first to appoint their SFA Club Development Officer, who will work alongside Cove Youth FC. Liam Duncan will work with Cove Youth FC for the next 6 months. Liam will work in partnership with Aberdeen Football Club Community Trust in delivering the McDonalds Community Club Project to Cove Youth FC. Liam said on the role: "It's an exciting project to be a part of. This is a great opportunity for Cove Youth FC, and the project is sure to make an already great club even better." The project will see Liam work specifically with the coaches of Cove Youth FC with the aim to mentor the coaches on specific aspects of the game. This in turn will feed back to the players of Cove Youth FC, as they reap the benefits of their coaches getting specific one to one work with a member of the Scottish Football Association. The project will see Liam work with several grassroots clubs within the city of Aberdeen over a 4 year period, however Cove Youth FC have been selected as the first club to receive the programme.
