Charleston Cove Development

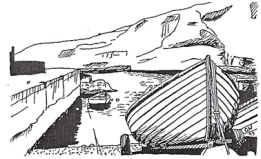
(Land to the north of Charleston School)
On the 24th February over 50 residents, members of the Community Council, a local Councillor and other interested parties, attended a presentation in Loirston School by CA Blackwell, the company contracted to reinstate the former landfill site for future housing development. There were many questions asked by concerned residents and these were answered by representatives from CA Blackwell, Fairhurst and Stewart Milne Homes. The remedial work will continue until September 2015.

Margaret Allan Legacy
