Planning Matters

Unusually for our area, there have been no contentious planning applications received recently!

Building of the Charleston housing development continues. Unfortunately the Developers are dragging their feet when it comes to many of their planning approval conditions, mostly roads related. The junction of South Loirston Road, as was, and Wellington Road will be closed off permanently as planned. Amongst other work outstanding are barriers at footpaths coming out of the development onto South Loirston Road.

Hydrogen Fuelling Station


Aberdeen's second hydrogen refuelling station was officially opened on Monday, 27 February along with the launch of a fleet of 10 hydrogen fuelled Toyota Mirai cars. Located on Langdykes Road in Cove, ACHES has four electric recharging points and has the potential to produce 130kg of hydrogen per day. 10 Toyota Mirai cars will be leased for three years with five going to the National Health Service (NHS), three to the Co-wheels car club, one to Scottish Environmental Protection Agency (SEPA) and one to Aberdeen City Council. The project is part funded by the UK Government Office for Low Emission Vehicles (OLEV) and Transport Scotland.

Lochside Academy

Discussions are still ongoing about the safest way to get our children to school across the extremely busy Wellington

Road. School buses, hopper buses for outwith school hours and a flyover are

among ideas being considered. Everyone agrees that safety is of paramount importance.
