## East Tullis Incinerator Update

### Timeline:

**6th October 2016:** Aberdeen City Council Granted Conditional Planning Approval

**24th October - 26th October:** three Councils - Moray, Aberdeenshire and Aberdeen City, agreed to spend approximately £6 million to advance financial and technical details.

**Present:** as part of the Stakeholder Group, the 4 Community Councils of Torry, Kincoth and Leggart, Cove and Altens and Nigg, consider their next move.

Placing this incinerator in the middle of residential areas is not a done deal.

## Planning Matters

Farmer Allan's unmade track onto Langdykes Road. The Planners are urging developers Scotia and Stewart Milne to get on with this work.

The new south of the City Academy now has a name. Lochside Academy came out as favourite.

There have been applications for residential alterations and extensions but no major developments this month so far.

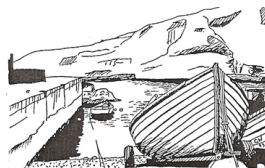
## Chronicle Deliverers
