Old Cove – Consultation on loss of conservation area status :

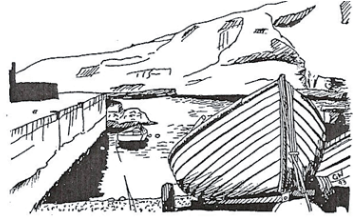
As yet we have had no update regarding this consultation.
