Planning Matters

The planning application for a Hydrogen Fuelling Station with on site Hydrogen Generation and Fuel Cells Systems on Langdykes Road comes before the Planning and Development Management Committee on 28th May and hopefully they will take into consideration our



objections. By the time you read this a decision will have been made which we hope will be in our favour.

Plans are still in the pipeline for a housing development at Allan Park and a new Secondary School at Calder Park.

The planning application for a Recycling and Waste Management Centre, Refuse Derived Fuel Plant and a Council Depot (south of Doonies Farm) has been lodged and the Community Council will be submitting its comments in due course.

A cycle and pedestrian link from the new housing development to Langdykes Road has to be provided as a condition of the planning consent together with a link to it from Newlands Lane North. Safety issues regarding the swale and SUDS pond have also been highlighted.
