The new timetable started in September and this should iron out most problems. If not, let First Bus 01224 650 000 know or email info@cove-bay.com

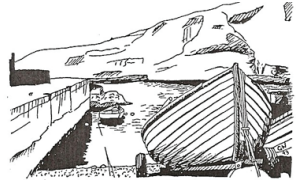
Planning Matters

Allan Park Development: A Planning Application for a sales office and carparking has been lodged. Scotia has applied to build 44 residential units. (11 dwelling houses and 33 flats) at Charleston south. Stewart Milne has applied to build 45 residential units at Charleston.

Proposed East Tullis Incinerator (Energy from Waste plant): Cove and Altens Community Council is working together with Torry, Kincorth/Leggart and Nigg Community Councils to stop this Incinerator being placed in the middle of our communities. Refuse would be brought from Moray and Aberdeenshire to be burned there along with City waste, resulting in increased heavy lorry traffic and air pollution .

Road Closure Cove Road/Loirston Road

A temporary Traffic Order will be in place between 10th and 14th October for



road resurfacing work to take place. An alternative route is available via Loirston Avenue and Earns Heugh Road although access to properties will be maintained.
